Dear Unit 302 Members,

It has been wonderful to see faces returning to the club. We hope that you will still be able to come in and support the club even without some of the amenities you are used to.

Following updates to the Order of the Provincial Health Officer, you will notice some changes when you come to the club. These changes include the following:

***Club open hours are now noon to 8:00, Wednesday to Sunday.** The club is closed on Monday and Tuesday. The kitchen is open Monday to Friday from 11:00 to 2:00 with service provided at the side window of the building, and inside counter during open hours.

***Members should choose a table upon entering and remain at that table unless going to the washroom or getting a drink. This means no table hopping, or visiting other tables.** Please lean one chair or use the color coded cards on the table to indicate you are leaving.

There continues to be a maximum of 6 persons per table.** Groups of 6 must be seated at tables that accommodate this numbers. ***Moving tables and/or chairs is not permitted.

***Please do not congregate, and avoid places where others gather.** This includes the main entrance and outside the building.

***A maximum of 2 people** can be at the bar for service. Please wait your turn.

Please be reminded of the following already established guidelines which are already in effect:

***If you are sick in any way; fever, cough, runny nose etc. do not attempt to come to the club. This is for the safety of both members and our staff.**

*Only ANAVETS members and spouses will be admitted until further notice. Seating has been limited to 49 people, and everyone entering the building is required to sign in at the front door and provide their membership / phone number.

*Social distancing protocols remain in effect. Tables have been arranged 2 meters or 6 feet apart and should not be moved. Please ensure the members you sit with are in your “bubble”.

*No underage children are allowed inside the club.

*The use of masks is still encouraged when not at your table. Disposable masks are available as you come in.

*One pool table will be available at a time, with a limit of 6 people for the billiards table or 4 people at a pool table.

A copy of the July 22 Order of the Provincial Health Officer is posted on the bulletin board in the front entry, as well as a letter received from Provincial Command for member reference.

Thank you for treating our staff and members with respect and kindness as we work within the limits of the current health order. We look forward to seeing you soon!
